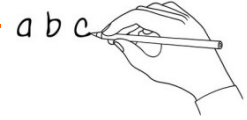




The lion and the mouse

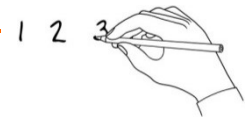


1. What's the word?

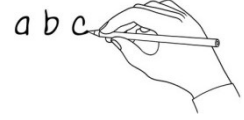

d. Does the lion think the mouse can help him?

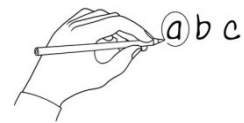
